A. Update on Route 9 Corridor Complete Streets Improvements project - Route 9 from 4th Street to Park College/Univ. Entrance Drive and from S. Crooked Road and Route FF to intersection with Route 9

Mayor Katerndahl stated that the project was in the concept review stage and a public meeting was held on March 10.

Chris Cline, Confluence, provided a summary of the first public meeting held on December 9, 2024, and the second public meeting held on March 10, 2025; presentation attached as Exhibit A.

Chris Novosel, George Butler Associates, responded to questions about traffic counts, traffic flow, traffic control options, and phasing different parts of the concepts. Further discussion focused on handicap parking north of the railroad tracks.

The next steps were to continue to accept comments from the public about the concepts, which would be summarized and presented to the Board of Aldermen at a future work session. The third public meeting would be held in late June.

Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 7356 Commander Joe Wolfgeher Jr., Tom Hustler, and Annette Hagan provided comments.
