

1. GENERAL AGENDA

Acting President of the Board opened the work session at 5:03 p.m. on October 12, 2020, at City Hall, 8880 Clark Avenue, Parkville. In attendance were aldermen Tina Welch, Philip Wassmer, Dave Rittman, Brian T. Whitley, Robert Lock, Douglas Wylie, Marc Sportsman, Greg Plumb.

A. Route 9 at 6th Street Improvements

Public Works Director Alysen Abel provided an overview of the project, noting that improvements were needed for the new office building at Route 9 and 6th Street. The primary focus of the improvements would be the addition of turn lanes recommended by a traffic study completed before the Six at Park building was built. Abel added that the City engaged George Butler Associates to provide engineering for the improvements.

Matt Graviett, George Butler Associates, provided an overview of the recommended improvements. He noted that the project would be bid in 2021 and the goal was to have a bid opening in February with construction to begin in the spring. The project had to be completed by July per the requirements of the Governor's Cost Share grant the City received for the improvements.

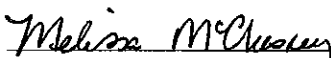
Abel added that several feet of the side streets would also be improved, along with storm sewer improvements to help with drainage issues. The retaining walls on the west side of Route 9 would not be changed. The utilities would be moved by the end of the year and some right-of-way would need to be required before the project could be released for bid.
